Distinguishing Features of this opportunity are...

The work involves responsibility for performing duties required in carrying out medical orders as prescribed by a licensed Veterinarian which requires an understanding of veterinary science. The Veterinary Technician assists in the practice of veterinarian medical care and regular maintenance of all animals at the shelter. There are some physical risks involved in the work due to the nature of the animal population. The employee may have to hold, move or lift animals in excess of 50 pounds in weight. Work is performed under the direct supervision of the Director and Deputy Director as well as, at times, under the general supervision of a licensed veterinarian. Supervision of subordinates is not a function of this class. Does related work as required.

Typical illustrative* work activities will include, but are not limited to...

- Animal assessment on intake;
- Prepares and administers medications on medical orders prepared by the veterinarian;
- Assists with anesthesia under the supervision of the veterinarian;
- Assists in surgical procedures and other medical procedures under the supervision of the veterinarian;
- Maintains complete, accurate and up-to-date animal health records, anesthetic records and controlled substance records;
