## **Job Description**

Provides assistance to the Maintenance Worker or higher-level Maintenance position in the Sewer District relating to the overall maintenance of buildings and equipment overseen by the Sewer District. Miscellaneous minor repair work may be performed independently, but does not require the same degree of proficiency and ability as that called for in the more skilled positions. General directions are received in connection with assignments and supervision is received while work is in progress and upon completion. Supervision is not typically a requirement of this title but some direction may be required over the work of laborers assigned to assist on specific tasks; Does related work as required. \*Shifts and schedule to be determined/discussed at interview level.

### Minimum Qualifications (at least)

Graduation from High School or possession of an equivalency diploma (GED) and one (1) year of full-time paid experience in manual labor in at least one of the major trades, such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical or HVAC, in a large-scale commercial setting.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT**: Candidate must possess, and maintain, a valid New York State Driver's License appropriate for the type of vehicle to be operated.

# **Typical Work Activities (\*Illustrative)**

- Assists in a wide variety of repairs to pumps, mechanical screens, gritting equipment, chlorine
  machines, sludge and grit conveyors, filters and piping and other pneumatic and hydraulic equipment;
- Assists in inspection and preventative maintenance on pumping machinery, conveyors, filters, grit chambers, and other plant equipment;
- Assists in installation and repair to electrical fixtures and circuits;
- Replaces defective fuses and light bulbs;
