Job Title: BUILDING MAINTENANCE HELPER

Job Description

In general, an employee in this class assists the Building Maintenance Worker or High-level Maintenance positions in the overall maintenance of buildings and equipment. This position may perform unskilled manual work in performing a variety of tasks connected with the operation, maintenance and cleaning of buildings and related equipment. Miscellaneous minor repair work may be performed, but it does not require the same degree of proficiency and ability as that called for in semi-skilled jobs of Building Maintenance Worker. General directions are received from a higher-ranking maintenance worker in connection with each assignment and supervision is received while work is in process and upon completion. Does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications (at least)

Graduation from High School or possession of an equivalency diploma (GED) and one year of full time paid experience in manual labor in at least one of the major trades, such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical or HVAC in a large scale or commercial setting.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Candidate must possess, and maintain, a clear and valid New York State Driver's License appropriate for the type of vehicle to be operated.

Typical Work Activities (*Illustrative)

- Performs minor carpentry work such as simple repairs to desks, tables, office furniture and shelving; Assists in installation and repair of general plumbing equipment such as sinks, toilets, etc.
 - Checks boilers for correct operation;
 - Helps to install and repair wiring systems and electric fixtures equipment and HVAC systems;
 - Prepares surface for painting by scraping, sanding, washing and applying paint and varnish remover;
 - Assists in the upkeep of grounds by mowing lawns, trimming shrubbery and taking care of flower beds;
 - Assists in a variety of tasks in regard to the upkeep of buildings such as cleaning, washing windows and scrubbing floors;

- Replaces defective fuses and light bulbs;
- Assists in installation and repair to electrical fixtures and circuits;
- Mixes plaster and concrete and assists in laying brick, plastering walls, finishing concrete work, etc.;

- May assist in cleaning bathrooms, hallways, rugs and polishes brass and metal work;
- May assist with the collection and removal of trash and garbage;
- Helps remove snow and ice from walks and driveways.
