



IS YOUR CHILD INTERESTED IN PART-TIME WORK AS A YOUTH INSPECTOR?

HERE'S WHAT PARENTS/GUARDIANS SHOULD KNOW:

- Inspectors play a critical role in preventing new smokers from starting. Inspectors between ages 17 and 20 try to buy tobacco products at stores to see if they'll sell to someone underage.

SAFETY FIRST:

- Inspectors work under the supervision of Public Health Inspectors.
- Compliance checks are not performed at locations where either the inspector is known or does not feel secure. To remain anonymous, inspectors do not present ID.
- A Public Health Inspector provides transportation.
- Inspections occur throughout Saratoga County.
- Saratoga County retailers have a 95% compliance rate.

Since 1997, Adolescent Tobacco Use Prevention Act (ATUPA) program inspectors have conducted 20,000 inspections throughout New York State.
