Job Description

The Senior Animal Shelter Aide is a manual labor position responsible for participating in and leading the work of a small group of Animal Shelter Aides, laborers and volunteers in routine, daily work related to the monitoring, care, treatment and maintenance of each animal which begins upon intake and continues throughout each animal's stay at the County Animal Shelter. Duties are performed under the direct supervision of the Director and Deputy Director of the Animal Shelter in accordance with established policies and procedures. Leading and participating with Animal Shelter Aides is exercised in the performance of specific tasks assigned by the Animal Shelter Director/Deputy Director. Incumbent will perform related duties as required.

Minimum Qualifications (at least)

Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma (GED) including three (3) years of full-time experience or its part-time equivalent in the care or treatment of domestic animals in a veterinarian's office, kennel, animal shelter, or related work place.

Typical Work Activities (*Illustrative)

- Leads and participates in the completion of tasks related to the intake, processing monitoring, medical treatment, daily care, housing, exercising, neutering, adoption redemption or disposition of lost, seized, sick or stray animals at the Animal Shelter following set policies and procedures;
- Leads and participates in the cleaning and disinfecting of animal holding areas, waiting rooms, isolation areas, office areas, storage areas, and surrounding grounds;
- Coordinates effective staffing schedules to ensure equal distribution and rotation of operational procedures and responsibilities required to meet the operational needs of the Shelter and the animals;
- Assists in coordinating, carrying out and maintaining adoption, volunteer and other applicable programs offered by the Shelter;
- Participation in clinics may be required in the absence of assigned personnel;
- Assists the general public and answers questions about the various programs in the Animal Shelter;

- Assists in the training and orientation of new shelter employees and volunteers ensuring thorough and complete familiarization of shelter operations and services;
- Maintains and prepares a variety of reports and records related to position requirements;
- Operates a variety of office equipment related to the daily operation of the Animal Shelter (personal computer, telephone, fax, scanner/copier);
- Performs related work as necessary.
