Job Description

The work involves responsibility for the performance of general laboring and/or construction tasks, which requires physical endurance and a willingness to perform arduous tasks at times in inclement weather. The incumbent generally uses hand and power tools to perform the work but may occasionally operate automotive equipment under close supervision of a qualified operator. The work is performed under direct supervision. Does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications (at least)

None is required. Some experience in heavy manual labor is desired.

NOTE: Currently four (4) vacancy opportunities. This is a temporary term expected to last through August.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Candidate must possess and maintain, a clear and valid New York State Driver's License appropriate for the **type** of vehicle to be operated, in meeting the necessary transportation needs of the job. This may include Class D, Class M/MJ, and Commercial (Class A,B,C) CDL

Typical Work Activities (*Illustrative)

- Performs a variety of manual labor tasks subject to inclement weather conditions;
- Rakes and shovels asphalt to patch potholes or assist in the paving of roads;
- Assists in the installation, maintenance and repair of sidewalks or other projects by shoveling, jackhammering, laying forms, and pouring cement;
- Assists in the installation, maintenance, and repair of pipeline by excavating, laying pipe, and backfilling;
- Assists in patching and grading of streets and building manholes;
- Loads and unloads trucks;
- Cuts brush, removes dead trees, plants grass, and mows lawns;
- Cleans debris from parking lots and culverts;
- Shovels snow and spreads salt;

- Operates power tools and equipment such as saws, mixers, jackhammers and tampers;
- Acts as a flag person on street jobs, coordinating safe pedestrian and traffic flow;
- Cleans vehicles and buildings;

- Assists in cleaning of tanks, vats, and channels;
- Performs related work as necessary.
